

12-Month Old Developmental Checklist

Developmental Checklist	Yes	Sometimes	Not Yet
Imitates simple actions			
Looks for objects removed from line of vision			
Predicts outcomes from events (e.g., pushing button moves toy)			
Puts objects in and out of containers			
Transfers objects from one hand to another			
Responds to sounds in home (e.g., looks up when phone rings)			
Understands at least 50 words			
Waves "bye-bye"			
Plays simple games like "patty-cake" or "peek-a-boo"			
Sometimes responds to simple commands (e.g., "come here")			
Uses at least five words on a daily basis			
Points and vocalizes as a way of obtaining objects			
Babbles and makes sounds while looking at a picture book			
Imitates new sounds and words			
Has acquired all skills on the 8-Month Old Checklist
