Follows five step directions			
Understands multiple meanings of words			
Recognizes non-literal meanings			
Uses some figurative language (e.g., figure of speech, idioms, metaphors)			
Comprehends abstract verbs			
Compares and contrasts information			
Reads a chapter of age-appropriate literature and answers questions regarding content			
Compares and contrasts new and old information			
Speech sounds are produced accurately			
Decodes multisyllabic words			
Knows the meaning of suffixes and prefixes and uses them to determine word meanings			
Identifies the main idea and details from texts			
Reads 80-100 correct words per minute			
Writes several paragraphs independently			
Initiates and ends conversations appropriately			
Asks for clarification of misunderstood verbal communication			
Responds to non-verbal cues during conversations
