

## 24-Month (2 Year) Old Developmental Checklist

Developinental checklist	res	Sometimes	not ret
Pretend play (e.g., feeds a doll, makes a toy fire truck spray water)			
Refers to self by name (e.g., Lilly do it)			
Tells you about recent events using real words, not made up words			
Verbalizes basic needs for food and drink			
Understands "in, on, off, under, big," and "little"			
Understands the meanings of 500-900 words			
Imitate most new words that you say			
Uses about 200 words			
Identifies about five body parts			
Uses words to create imaginary events			
Uses speech that is 75% understandable to friends and families			
Follows simple one-step commands (e.g., give me the ball)			
Combines two to three words (e.g., 'more milk', 'Daddy go byebye')			
Responds to your questions most of the time			
Talks a lot while playing with other children			
Uses "me, you", and "mine", although not always correctly			
Has acquired all the skills on the 18-Month Checklist
